New Digital Forensics Program



York PD is in the process of implementing a Digital Forensics program, spearheaded by Sgt. Kiera Fayall. Detectives will now be able to extract and analyze digital data from most cell phones, computers, tablets and other digital devices, as well as, clouds, hard drives, SD cards and USB cards.

As this city grows and the criminal mind is ever adapting, this tool will help Officers investigate cases ranging from financial & fraud cases to egregious assault cases. In most cases, York PD deals with a digital device or phone used either in the commission of the crime or contains information to assist us on solving the crime.

Parks and Recreation

The City of York's Parks and Recreation Department has been hard at work! Here are a just a few things that they're working on to create more opportunities to the residents of York.

- Construction on City Park Phase II is underway. This phase will consist of an outdoor amphitheater and permanent restroom facilities. Construction is expected to be completed by June 2024.
- Construction has started on the batting cages at the York Recreation Complex.
- The new scoreboard for field 4 at the York Recreation Complex has been ordered and is expected to be installed Mid-April.

AMI Installation Update

All base station sites were successfully commissioned and brought online on Thursday, March 21, 2024. The next phase started on Monday, March 25, 2024, and involves integrating billing and installing test meters. The City has chosen 13 sites that are representative of the service area for the test meter installations. Once these meters are installed, the system will be monitored to ensure the viability of connections and data reads.
